2. Alumni, students and teachers felt that the curriculum should incorporate more practicalexperiential learning. By site interaction visits, with the professionals from industry or mockup interaction client sessions, etc.

Interactions with various professionals from the field of interior design should be promoted in multiple ways on a regular basis to make students aware of the actual professional handling of practice addition to in theoretical knowledge.

Practicing interior designers from core and visiting faculty are a part of the interior design studio team that helps the students get an insight into the process of practical know-how on a regular basis. In addition to this, "Insights Lecture Series" which was first introduced in 2014, conducted 16 lectures during the academic year 2022-23. Through this series, students got to learn practicing and interact with interior designers from the field, about their practices, know functioning of offices, design projects, site handling etc.

Panel discussions with practicing interior designers were conducted during the college festival "Aakar" for understanding the business of Interior Design.

Students were introduced to the basics of a business set up through a Masterclass on "7 Pillars of business set-up". The students were taught about finances, legal framework, team structure and management, marketing, branding and sales, customer management and business viability.

Students were taken to various field visits where they could study on-going interior design projects.

Considering the importance of the client-interior designer interaction, the institute believes that the suggestion from the stakeholders to conduct mockup client interviews can be a good opportunity for students to learn practical aspects of the interior design industry.

The arrangement shall be made in the academic year 2023-24 to accommodate mockup client interviews in the curriculum.
