A. Specify the semester wise Course objectives and the exercises devised

ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN Course Objectives: Architectural education has evolved beyond design and technology in its pursuit of finding its identity through Art, Science and Humanity. So, the learnings of Architecture also emphasised self consciousness and empathy and derived itself as a multifaceted, diverse discipline yet with indigenous character and not just as an empirical process. The intent of the Semester I Architectural design studio is to develop the understanding of space, scales and proportions through Architecture as a narrative. It also focuses on developing the architectural vocabulary and improving visualization skills. In this semester the students are also introduced to working with different planes (overhead planes, vertical planes and horizontal planes), creating levels, working with regulating lines and exploring space creation. **Exercises Devised:** For semester 1 batch of 2021-22 the studio started with anthropometrics exercise. Second exercise was rural and urban narrative. Where the mapping of spatial and cognitive memories through storytelling, analysis with creative yet critical thinking formed an important part of the process. It also equipped them to develop skills of converting the narratives (Pictorial, Experiential, Visual and Verbal) into a graphical representation. Further to create experiential spaces using vertical architectural elements and levels through a series of processes of composition, orientation, and spatial exploration an exercise on Line Dot and Curve was introduced which focuses on space-shape-volume relationships through their visual perception, Sense and Spatial Exploration, Relationship between horizontal and vertical planes with help of regulating Lines, Composition in three dimensions. **ALLIED DESIGN Course Objectives:** Basic Design being the first module, is aimed to embed students with the core principles of Basic Design - contrast, balance, emphasis, proportion, hierarchy, repetition, rhythm, pattern, white space, movement, variety, and unity along with essential design qualities such as aesthetics, proportions, materiality, colour, and so on. The Basic Design Studio priority begins with team building exercises to create a platform for exchange of ideas and skills. Two dimensional compositional exercises are imperative in learning the principles of Basic Design. Process of Abstraction helps the students to conceptualize their designs and enhance their creative skills. It opens their thoughts to multiple possibilities and interpretations. With a student teacher ratio of 12:1, regular qualitative discussions are conducted to achieve the optimum design resolution. Each student is encouraged to have multiple iterations at every stage by offering essential parameters creating opportunities for a better understanding of the Basic Design Principles. **Exercises Devised:** For Semester I - batch of 2021-22, the first exercise was to create a video reel in groups, showcasing their personas and inclinations. The second exercise was "A composition of Fractals", where the students had to generate a fractal from a complex household object and design a balanced two dimensional composition of negative and positive spaces, pertaining to The Principles of Basic Design. The third exercise was, "Interpreting Sculptures", where students were to interpret an existing abstract sculpture, associate a proverb to it and translate the proverb into an abstract sculptural model, to fulfil the design prerequisites of proportion, scale, and materiality.

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ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN Course Objectives: The Aim of Semester II Architectural design studio was to understand the importance of context and the ways in which the structure should react to the context. To develop the contextual understanding we as an institute believe it is important to consider a physical site. Hence for the students of 2021-22 batch a site visit was conducted to Pawna lake at Lonavla where students marked the site boundary and site levels by methods of surveying and levelling. They also studied existing features on the site and site surroundings. Further in studio classes students were guided in groups of 1:10 ratio (1 faculty for 10 students) to develop detailed client profiles and design spaces relevant to the same. The client profile was derived by interviewing the users to understand their needs and aspirations. **Exercise Devised:** For Semester II - batch of 2021-22, the 12-week exercise "Lake house at Pawna" was introduced. A family second home to be designed which respects the site conditions, climate and user requirements. As case studies an exercise was introduced to study houses done by famous Architects. This exercise along with providing exposure intended to understand space, circulation, architectural representation, and design concepts. The case study structures were studied and analyzed by preparing drawings on 1:100 scale and making operable three dimensional models. **ALLIED DESIGN Course Objectives:** It is important to stimulate the understanding of the Semester I Basic Design studio - composition and form. The aim of Semester II Basic Design Studio is to develop a three-dimensional model based on a two-dimensional composition in order to learn the perception of space. Space-shape-volume relationships, Scale and Spatial Exploration, are key intents for the studio exercises. The exercises are intended to explore configurations of different types of planes - depressions, elevated planes, vertical planes, and overhead planes and elements, generating spaces which are then appropriated to human activities and scale. The composition allows multiple spaces to be connected in hierarchy. The introduction of parameters such as colors, textures, and penetrations edify the students regarding the transformation potential of space. This studio is designed to directly relate the Basic Design Studio to Architecture Design where the application of the learnings translate into human centric spaces. **Exercise Devised:** For Semester II - batch of 2021-22, the 12-week exercise "Tessellation & System of Grids", where the students had to generate a grid using one of the Tessellations of M.C. Escher after tracing it, identifying the negative & positive spaces and the pattern of the composition. This Grid was then transformed into a new two-dimensional composition. The extrusion of profiles of the composition into various planes and giving a Human Scale to the model, the students were able to develop spatial understanding and possibilities of non conventional functions as a response to human activities.

ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN - Sem 3 Course objectives: Semester 3 architectural design studio focused on the basis of creating and developing architectural forms in a public realm as a foundational learning exercise for architecture students. The studio drew inspiration from one of the principal books in architecture, Form, Space and Order, by Francis D. K. Ching to apply the theoretical and methodical approach mentioned in the book for designing a public space that is aesthetically pleasing, functionally sound and creates a dialogue with its surroundings. Along with it, the studio aimed to reevaluate one of the essential roles of public spaces as a formal display ground for art to a 21st-century inclusive and comfortable public space. Therefore, the studio intended to explore the potential of a public space to exhibit and encourage art for one or more reasons of pleasure, knowledge, awareness, or marketing. **Exercise devised:** This studio worked in a collaboration with the Architectural Theory course. To begin with, the concept of form, space and its organization and its relevance in architecture was discussed. A Form Development workshop followed, in which students made physical models and hand sketches as a tool throughout the process to research and design different aspects of architectural form. Simultaneously, the studio worked closely with the Architectural Theory course to strengthen the understanding of the contextual factors that contribute to architectural form development as a public space. Finally, students were expected to make a presentation of all the necessary analyses, drawings, and models to explain their process. **ALLIED DESIGN STUDIO (Interior Design) - Sem 3 Course objectives:** In semester three of allied design, we continued Interior Design as an allied subject. In which the aim of the design program was - to understand and analyze residential spaces, their functions and qualities, which, when coming together, create an aesthetic and comfortable environment. It is to understand the concept of a 1BHK apartment and design an efficient, comfortable, habitable space based on one's family profile. To conceptualize the aesthetics of the 1BHK apartment, the program expects students to understand multiple functions: living, sleeping, cooking and hygiene spaces and how they are going used throughout the day or especially in one's routines. This design study includes attributes like anthropometry, flooring, colour, texture, pattern, light, balance, vegetation, furniture detail, etc. **Exercise devised:** The studio demands a graphical explanation of the chosen function using architectural plans and sections (drawn to scale) along with activity diagrams. In addition to that, photographs & sketches can be added to illustrate the various activities carried out in the said space, to explain the overall spatial quality of the said function. Finally, every presentation was concluded with an inference based on the functions and attributes (simulation, movement, the impact of daily routine, overlaps and duration of different activities, age groups, functional services, architectural methods, etc.)

ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN - Sem 4 Course objectives: In semester 4 the architectural design studio was based on the importance and necessity of contextual design in current architectural practices. The studio intended to apply the three main pillars of sustainability i.e., social, economic, and environmental, as theoretical, and methodical approaches to propose an architectural intervention of SOS Village. The design that the studio would like to achieve will be socially significant, economically feasible and environmentally responsive to the surrounding natural and cultural envelope. The studio also incorporated the core mission of the SOS village which is to build families for children in need; help them, shape their futures, and share in the development of the communities, as an integral part of the design process and outcomes. Therefore, the studio aimed not only to create an opportunity for an impact on three children but also on the social and natural environment in which the village is situated. **Exercise devised:** The studio worked closely with the Architectural Theory course and the Case Study Method course. To begin with, the analysis of the site and its surrounding region was discussed. Detailed case studies of the existing SOS villages were followed next. After that students came up with a set of strategies for the contextual design based on their initial research. Simultaneously, the studio sought assistance from the Architectural Theory course to strengthen the understanding of spatial sustainability as well as with the Case Study method course to provide a systematic approach to using case studies in the architectural design process. Finally, students were expected to make a presentation of all the necessary analyses, drawings, and models to explain their process. **ALLIED DESIGN STUDIO (Interior Design) - Sem 4 Course objectives:** In semester three of allied design, we continued Interior Design as an allied subject. In this studio, we focused on enhancing students' understanding of interior design for a commercial space to give a holistic perspective on this substream of architecture. The aim of the design program was to understand and analyze brand philosophy and product details to effectively design the display for the products and the Experience Centre for the same. It focuses on developing a design which creates a visual impact of the product, on its customers. **Exercise devised:** Understanding the Brand Profile and study of their products along with Concept development, iteration on the concept with respect to placement in the display area, and use of colour and textures to form a mood board. Design development in the form of Plan and Front Elevation, supported by sketches and 3D views. All drawings must be adequately labeled and dimensioned to ensure a complete understanding. Final Presentation as an integrated study of a brand, its philosophy, understanding of product's details, concept and mood board, Plan and Front elevation as complete and legible architectural design drawings, views and sketches to support one's design.

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Architectural Design - Sem 5 (Searching for a New Balance between Form and Functionality) Course Objectives: The main aim of the semester was to explore a form oriented design that is predominantly governed by function and circulation. The exploration of the built form was encouraged to optimize the spaces, creating an institution that is landmark in appearance and commands respect in functionality. The design project also focused on making an intervention that behaves as a catalyst which will regenerate the urban fabric and add a new dimension in the context of the city, the creation of which will act as a guideline or path that drives society forward. The objective of the project was to understand the ways in which spaces are designed specifically to enhance the experience of the user even in a building purely designed based on functionality. It also focused on studying the existing site, present conditions and restrictions and provided design iterations suitable keeping those in mind. It also encouraged the students to establish a connection between the functionality of the project through user oriented design. The project being a public building was envisaged to be more than just function oriented design. The built form needed to represent the importance of the building while creating it to be a landmark. The design was inspired to be sensitive to the past, present and future of the site and context, celebrating history and culture. **Exercise Devised:** Based on the above mentioned course objectives, the semester 5 architectural design focused on designing the District court building. The design of the courtroom being driven by functional requirements such as clear sightlines and good acoustics, architectural traditions starting with early one-room courthouses and continuing to the Supreme Court, and modern thinking about the evolution of justice towards a more restorative model was expected as design outcome at the end of the exercise. It is always important to balance the desire for unique specialty courtrooms with the flexibility needed over the long life of a civic building. Keeping this structure in mind 15 courtrooms had to be proposed along with mandatory spaces for judicial staff. The support facilities and utility blocks that support the daily activities of the working of the courthouse were also a part of the design brief. The total built up for the courthouse was expected to be around 4500 to 5000 sq m on a site area of 3.91 acres. The site was located at Kuria which currently houses the district court. Along with the various design aspects of functionality being in prominence, it was equally important to consider the design from the outside-in. The design project of the courthouse made sure that it has a significant architectural presence that will engage in the civic dialog of its site, embodying the presence of justice in a specific community. The design was guided and encouraged to be sensitive to the past, present and future of the site and context, celebrating history and culture.

Architectural Design - Sem 6 (URBAN LIVEABILITY : SENSE OF BELONGANCE IN THE URBAN CHAOS) Course Objectives: The project was focused on the understanding and interpretation of various dimensions of liveability. It investigated relations between densities of the built environment and indicators of four socio-economic qualities of livable cities: accessibility, social diversity, Cultural Identity, Informal activities. The project taught the students the various aspects of public spaces like how they should be built on the lived experiences of the surrounding area. The Aim of this project was to design an inclusive and self-sufficient environment for community development. It also aims to bridge the gap between the community and the visitors by providing spaces for interaction. Various interactive, expressive and skill building activities will help promote self-sufficiency. The project also focuses on engaging the students in developing a design framework that is inclusive and site responsive and focuses on catering to the importance of relation between individuals of communities and amenities needed by them. The main objective of the project was to create a public space that encourages public interaction which would act as a backdrop of the community center that promoted and embodied the spirit of community involvement. The community center acts as a socio-cultural hub - a platform for interaction between community and visitors, bridge between various age groups, user groups, social groups etc. **Exercise Devised:** Architectural design project focused on designing a community or neighbourhood centre that becomes a hub for social equity and community capacity building. The design project proposes to embody spaces with an ideal, an ideal that is based upon its role in the facet of character development. The project expected the students to have individual conceptualization of envisioning the public place space. The total site area given for the project was approximately 9 acres in the dense locality of Chumbur in Mumbai city. Minimum of 1/3rd of the site would ideally be expected to embody the public space. The said public spaces may include for e.g. activities of public nature includes of various age groups, gardens, group activities etc. They may also include informal markets, amphitheatre, flea markets, other dynamic spaces to accommodate local facilities, special occasions and community gatherings. A community building space must provide facilities for individuals to enrich themselves and educate themselves. The individuals can also enhance various sports skills. The area considerations for the various activities was to be deduced by the students by establishing the proposed feasibility of the various activities and the number of people to which the spaces shall be catering to at the given point of time. These spaces could be categorized as libraries, sports facilities etc. These spaces can be envisaged as sports facilities, safety rooms for kids, day care centres for kids with multiple age appropriate activities. The community forum should provide a platform to gain knowledge. A community building space must provide facilities for individuals to enrich themselves and educate themselves.

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ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN - SEM 9 Course Objectives: Collection and analysis of data related to the Design topic. Site selection, study and planning. Understanding climatic, socio economic, user study, demographics, traffic patterns and cultural layers impacting design. The expected outcome is aimed at integrating architecture in an urban scenario for urban commercial, transportation, recreation, entertainment activities for masses with respect to architectural forms, their grouping and composition, architectural detailing, required infrastructure and services. The Design Exercise - 'Infill Development' The design brief evolved from the concept of Infill development for the need and performance of the urban socio-cultural fabric of an area. The students had to identify a defunct plot in a range of 5000 to 10000 sq. m within their area of study for an appropriate activity/ function after detailed study of the area. The typology of buildings derived through the site study and analysis could be diverse and open to interpretation and justification. It varied in scale and functions - eg. a municipal school, community center, crematorium, neighborhood market, waste management center etc. The architectural programme needed to be sustainable and rooted to the context along with exploration of design sensibilities. The final output had to express the design idea with a mature narrative, presentation, services and technical understanding of the design. The project was conducted in pairs of students and the studio was conducted online. DESIGN DISSERTATION - SEM 9 (Research Thesis) Course objectives Students were required to choose a topic and conduct research under the guidance of their thesis guide. They were required to submit a report in a prescribed research format. The report was expected to include the title and description of the topic and its justification for an architectural intervention in the site context. Background study, review of related literature, analysis of data, methodology of study (Survey, Case studies, project reviews) findings and analysis based on the methodology was expected. Design programme along with an appropriate site was required with the selection criteria for the same. Site study and the relevance for the Architectural programme needed to be established. All base studies needed to be included before starting the design process in semester 10. There was a strict check on the content with respect to plagiarism and referencing. The Studio progressed via multiple stages of evaluation and defense as a process to strengthen the research report. The overall process focused towards developing a critical thinking approach towards the topic of study. Understanding a broader picture through reading literature, case studies and other sources was initiated. Finally the students ability to analyse the data in a formal research writing format and appropriate referencing was aimed at. The inferences were further driven towards a relevant design intervention as an application of the research study.

DESIGN DISSERTATION AND ARCHITECTURAL REPRESENTATION AND DETAILING - Sem 10 Course Objectives: The process of design dissertation had to be taken ahead from the research component in Semester 9. Application of the inferences were required to be linked to the design ideas. The Sem. 9 Design process was articulated in a small way like the Design Dissertation therefore the students benefited from its learnings. Design Dissertation and Architectural representation and Detailing are taken in conjunction as prescribed by the University guidelines. All subject engagements like ARD, Elevates, ASC, EVS and Architectural theory were oriented towards idea generation, application in their design. A holistic approach towards the project to near resolution was expected. The students were guided by their respective dissertation guides and ARD inputs by technical and TOB faculty. Reviews of all stages were done jointly for better and robust feedback and defense. Studio Outcome: The students were able to advance their designs to a reasonable degree but were able to have a robust understanding with respect to its services and technicalities.
