1. All students will have to fill the "Eligibility/Registration Form" of the University of Mumbai.
2. Students under the General (Open) Category admitted through CAP Allotment with a family annual income of less than 8 lakh and having a Maharashtra domicile certificate can apply for scholarships for economically weaker sections (Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Yojna).
3. Students under EWS, SC/ST, SBC/ VJNT, OBC will have to apply for government scholarships. If a student fails to apply or his/her application gets rejected from the scholarship department due to any reason will have to pay balance fees to the institute.
4. Girls Students under EWS, OBC, SEBC, EBC and Open will have to apply for government scholarship where in the total family annual income is 8.00 Lakhs or below 8.00 Lakhs. If a student fails to apply or his/her application gets rejected from the Scholarship department due to any reasons will have to pay balance fees to the Institute

1. Candidate belonging to Boards other than State Board viz CBSE/ ICSE / IB is applicable to pay Rs. 300/- the fees is included in the fees for the purpose of eligibility.
2. Candidates belonging to Boards other than boards viz CBSE/ ICSE / IB must submit verification report of 12th Mark Sheet from their respective Boards.

- a) Applicants From Schedule castes, Various Backward Classes and Economically Backward Classes Who have Confirmed their final admission can avail the benefit under state government various scholarship / Freeship schemes etc. by applying online through state government <https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in/> portal.
- b) For availing the prescribed benefit of scholarship/ freeship schemes, etc. the candidate must fulfill the scheme eligibility and submit online application through mahadbt portal within one month from the date of securing final admission in the college/ institution.
- c) As per Government Decision No. Shishyavru-2024/P.No.105/Tanshi-4, dated 8th July, 2024, Girl students admitted through the Centralized Admission Process-CAP (excluding management quota/institution level admission) conducted by the competent authority of the Government, girl student who are newly admitted as well as previously admitted (renewal of application), whose annual family income is Rs. 8.00 lakhs or below, and belonging to economically weaker sections, Other Backward Classes, Common and Educationally Backward Classes, and who are taking admission in such vocational courses, the following departments viz. The Department of Higher and Technical Education, Medical Education and Pharmaceuticals Department, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department and Other Backward Bahujan Welfare Department, have given 100 percent benefit from the academic year 2026-27 instead of 50 percent benefit of Tuition fee and Examination fee.



Application Procedure for VACANT SEATS (IF ANY) after CAP Rounds
